### 1 Ramen Yotsuba

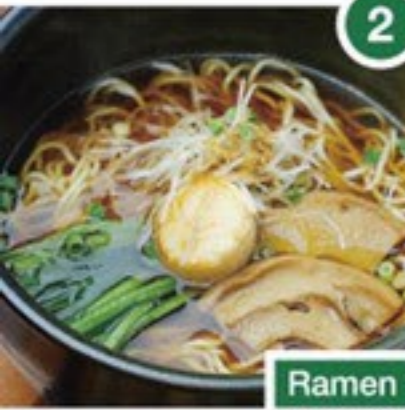


Ramen

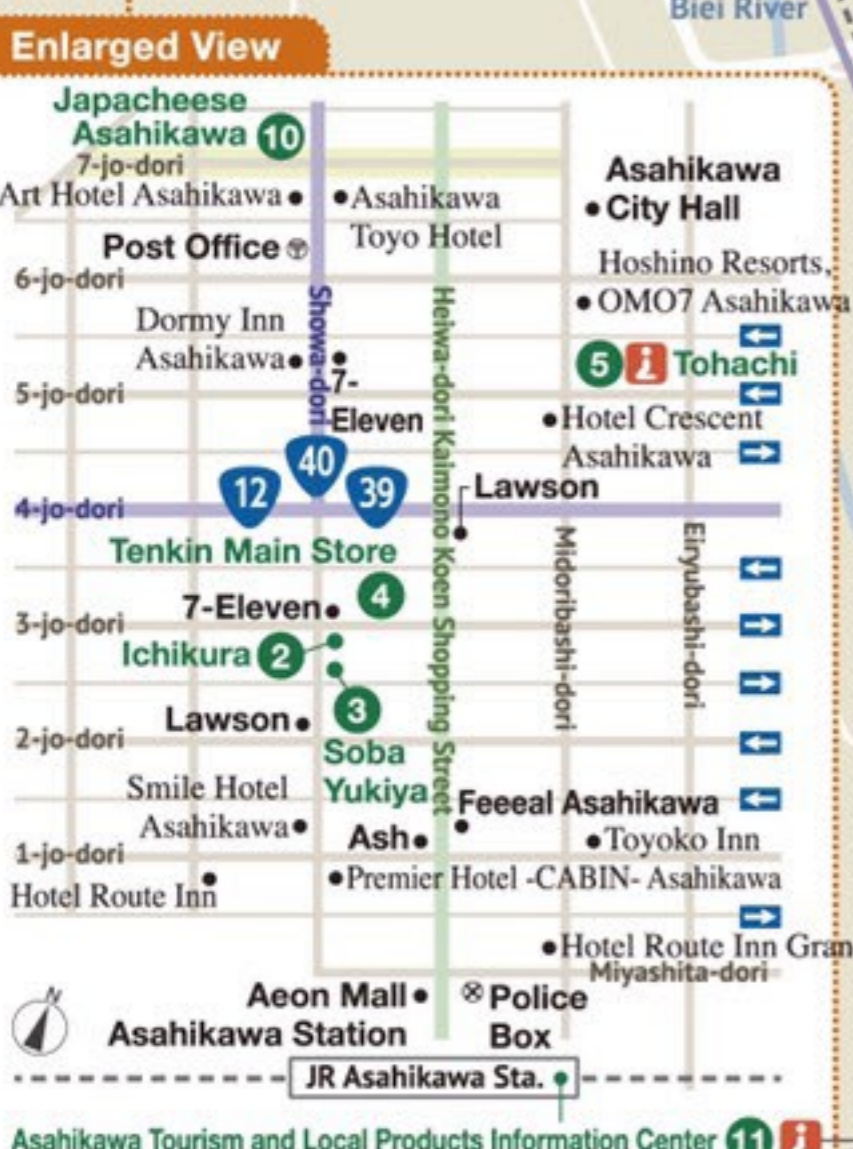


## Asahikawa City, Hokkaido
